

## **Proviso Township High Schools District 209 Board of Education Goals & Superintendent's Priorities, 2013-2016 Progress Update Highlights, June 30, 2014**

### **Goal 1: Improve Educational Performance of All Students**

- All 3 schools saw gains in PSAE scores in both Reading and Math.
- ACT average composite scores increased in all 3 schools.
- The number of students who took AP and Honors classes increased at Proviso West. PMSA offered 9 AP and Dual Enrollment courses with enrollments of 297 for the first time.
- The number of students inducted into the National Honor Society increased by 56% across the District.
- The attendance rate improved at Proviso West, while the number of total tardies dropped at Proviso East and PMSA.

### **Goal 2: Improve Resource Management**

- A Benefits Fair and an IMRF Retirement Seminar were held in the Fall 2013 and Winter, 2014 respectively.
- New teacher and substitute teacher orientation resources and programs were developed and implemented.
- An induction program prototype was developed for pilot implementation in 2014-15.
- Monies from grants increased by 35%.
- The District Financial Plan was approved by both the Board of Education and the Financial Oversight Panel.
- The District had a clean audit report and a balanced budget in the highest category.

### **Goal 3: Improve Community Relations**

- The District hosted 9 community outreach activities.
- The District expanded recipients of a weekly newsletter and established a Twitter and YouTube presence.
