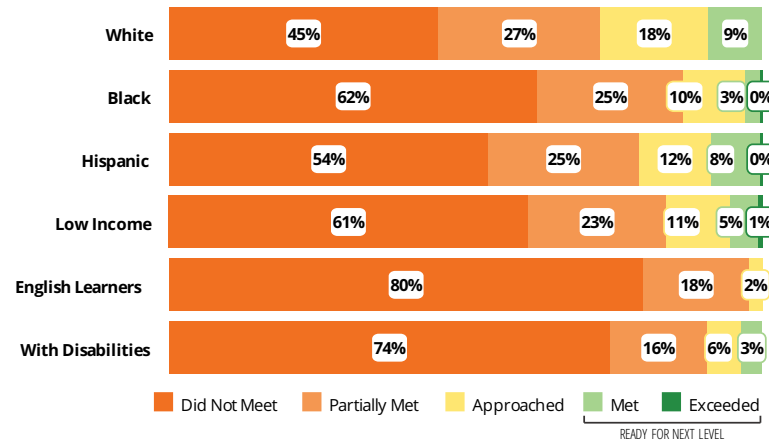
Academic Success

Success by Student Group

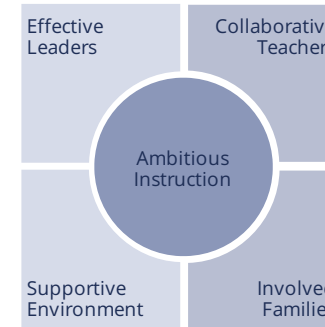
This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.



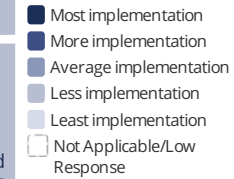

The **5Essentials Survey** allows students in grades 6-12 and all teachers to share their perspectives on essential conditions for learning. The anonymous survey consists of 5 components.



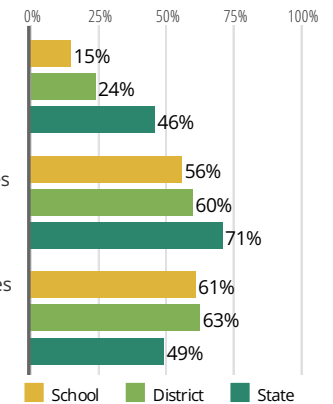

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Proviso West is a comprehensive high school with college prep, fine arts and career-based programs. Course offerings are available at the Honors and Advanced Placement levels. Industry certifications can be attained within Career and Technical Education courses. Proviso West is recognized and a Project Lead The Way and Naval Junior ROTC school.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Physical Education and Health courses at Proviso West are designed to promote and teach positive life long habits of mental and physical well-being. Students will participate in team and self-directed fitness activities that allow for collaboration and encourage personal goal setting.

Other Programs and Activities

Proviso West students are involved in a number of clubs and activities designed to provide opportunities for academic enrichment, special interests, or personal growth. Some of programs assist students in meeting the forty hours of community service required for graduation. New clubs or activities may be offered based on student interest.

School Awards

Proviso West students were accepted to 53 universities and colleges and earned over 11 million dollars in scholarships in 2016. Students were recognized at a number of competitions and events: Des Plaines Valley Region Culinary Competition (1st Place), Wrestling Regional Champion, and the NJROTC Distinguished Unit Award.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Proviso West offers a wide selection of Career and Technical Education courses designed to encourage pursuit of a career pathway in the areas of technology, culinary arts, human growth/development and transportation. Many courses lead to industry certification and are offered through Triton Community College for dual credit.

Athletics

Proviso West High School is a member of the West Suburban Conference and offers team and individual athletic competition opportunities at all grade levels. Freshmen students are expected to participate in at least one extra-curricular activity as part of their transition to a successful high school experience.

School Personnel Resources

The counselors and social workers at Proviso West High School provide career, college and social-emotional support services to students through classroom and group activities, individual counseling, teacher/parent consultation, and community referrals. It is our mission to inspire future leaders who are resilient and socially responsible.

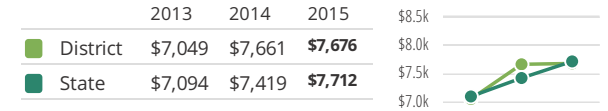
Facilities

Proviso West was founded in 1958 and is one of three high schools in Proviso Township High School District 209 located in west suburban Chicago, Illinois. 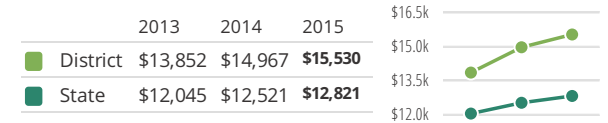
Most of this data has been collected by ISBE from school districts through data systems. Some information, such as the School Highlights, is entered directly by principals and can be updated throughout the year.

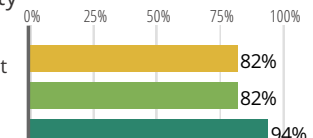
Educator Measures

Student Attendance and Mobility

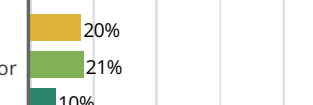
Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



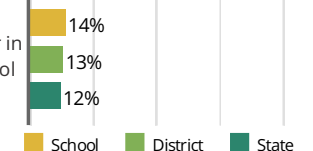
Chronic Truancy Rate
