Students in the classes below will take the suite of SAT practice tests 2 times this year in preparation for the actual state exam that will be given on April 9, 2019. All 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders will be taking the official SAT as a state requirement. Ninth graders will complete the PSAT8/9, 10<sup>th</sup> graders will complete PSAT 10, and 11<sup>th</sup> graders will complete SAT.

	• Students who are absent on September 12 will take a makeup test on September 13, 14, 17 or 18. After the makeup test, they will go to their usual classes for the remainder of the school day.
	<ul> <li>Encourage students to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast.</li> <li>School breakfast will be served as usual.</li> </ul>

Students <u>Not</u> Testing	• Seniors will engage in self-directed college visits or community service required for graduation. They will not attend regular classes on these dates.

When practice tests are scored, students will receive individual score reports with guidance to understand their strengths and suggestions to improve areas of weakness. The results for the April 9<sup>th</sup> assessment shall be released in the fall by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE).
