

THE IB CORE & DP COURSES

Student who select to the IB-CP can expect to engage in a rigorous set of courses and experiences their junior and senior years. These courses will include:

- At least two courses from the Diploma Programme
 - Mathematics: Applications and Interpretation (Standard Level)
 - English Language & Literature (Standard Level)
- At least two courses from their chosen College & Career Academy Program of Study
- One course in personal and professional skill development
- Service-learning initiatives, a reflective project, and world language development

WHAT ARE PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL SKILLS?

WHAT IS LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT?

- Aim is for multicultural fluency
- Students complete a minimum of 50 hours learning a language that is not their native language
- Students develop language and cultural understanding

WHAT IS SERVICE LEARNING?

- Students complete a minimum of 50 hours of service learning
 - Identify own strengths and develop areas for growth
 - Demonstrate participation with service learning experiences
 - Demonstrate the skills and recognize the benefits of working collaboratively
 - Demonstrate engagement with issues of global significance
 - Recognize and consider the ethics of choices and actions

WHAT IS THE REFLECTIVE PROJECT?

• The Reflective Project is an in-depth body of work (essay, play, storyboard, graphic presentation, video, etc.) produced over the duration of the IBCP program and is submitted at the end of your coursework. It is designed to draw together key elements of the IBCP program: Career-related studies (CTE), Community and Service Learning, and the Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) course. You will need to identify an ethical issue/dilemma, stemming from your career-related studies, which you would like to explore in greater depth.

Goals of the Reflective Project

- Engage in personal inquiry, action and reflection (PLAN, DO, REFLECT) on a specific ethical issue.
- Develop research and communication skills.
- Develop the skills of critical and creative thinking.

WHEN WILL I DECIDE IF CP IS FOR ME?

- Demonstrate interest as an incoming freshman
 - Take preparatory courses during 9th and 10th grade (Honors and AP)
- Apply during enrollment in the fall of freshman year
 - GPA and attendance
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Personal essay
 - Participation in an eligible Academy program of study such as PLTW, Computer Science, Allied Health with the CNA option, etc.
- Official confirmation of acceptance in the spring of freshman year
