CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to the Park Policies already in place at Six Flags Great America, the following Rules and Regulations apply during GRAD NITE:

- \checkmark Community service hours must be turned in to counselor prior to purchasing ticket

DRESS CODE

Please dress appropriately for the weather; students who fail to adhere to the proper dress code will not be allowed to board the bus to the amusement park.
