

### Why choose the MSA Program at PTHS D209?

- ➤ Math & Science Academies are at all three campuses:
  - Proviso Math & Science Academy in Forest Park (PMSA)
  - Proviso East Math & Science Academy in Maywood (PEMSA)
  - Proviso West Math & Science Academy in Hillside (PWMSA)
- ➤ All MSA campuses provide a high level of rigor and pacing for students who have met the admissions criteria for acceptance.
- ➤ Grade Point Average (GPA) is weighted.
- > Students take a required research course in preparation for AP & IB as upperclassmen.
- > All 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are encouraged to apply.



# Which MSA school can my student attend?

- ➤ All three campuses provide the same rigorous math and science academy coursework for students admitted into the program.
- > The only difference is location.
- ➤ Cut scores for admission are determined by enrollment capacity for the incoming freshman class of 2027.
- The top 200 students (approx.) whose cumulative score is above the cut score will be invited to choose between PMSA or their home school MSA, either PEMSA or PWMSA.
- The next 100 students (approx.) for each home school will be invited to their MSA campus, PEMSA or PWMSA.



### Why choose the MSA Program at PTHS D209?

The MSA course pathway differs from Proviso East & Proviso West non-academy students in grades 9-10 in preparation for AP & IB coursework in grades 11-12.

# Who can apply for admission?

- ➤ Any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who currently attends one of the Proviso Township High School (PTHS) District 209 (D209) foundation schools
- ➤ Any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who currently attends a private school or is home-schooled whose permanent residence is within the PTHS D209 boundaries
- ➤ Any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who currently attends a middle school that is out of district, but whose permanent residence will be within the PTHS D209 boundaries by the time of enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year



### What are the MSA Admission Requirements At-a-Glance?

- 1. Fill out and submit the digital Math and Science Academy (MSA) Admissions Application, which will go live on the PTHS D209 website on October 30, 2022 and close on January 15, 2023.
- 2. Complete TWO (2) assessments between November 7 and December 10, 2022.
- 3. Have your 7th grade transcript uploaded and submitted to PTHS D209 by your school's registrar or counselor no later than January 15, 2023 using the Google Form provided.

Let's Unpack These Requirements...



- 1. Fill out and submit the digital Math & Science Academy (MSA) Admissions Application, which will go live on the PTHS D209 website on October 30, 2022 and close on January 15, 2023
  - ➤ The <u>Admissions Application</u> was developed on *Microsoft Forms*. There is no paper version.
  - Applications will be submitted directly to our district secured network and <u>all</u> student contact information will be protected.
  - > Each field on the electronic application must be completed.
  - ➤ Each field is presented in English and Spanish. Responses may be written in English or Spanish.

#### 2. Complete TWO (2) assessments between November 7 and December 10, 2022

PSAT 8/9: This paper-pencil test will be administered at all foundation schools between November 7 and November 21, 2022.

- PSAT 8/9 is from the College Board and assesses students' skills in reading and math.
- Students will need a #2 pencil and a calculator.

NNAT3: This **online test** will be administered at all foundation schools between November 7 and November 30, 2022.

- This assessment is a nonverbal measure of students' reasoning and problemsolving abilities. It consists of problems that use a complex set of geometric shapes and designs without words or reading required.
- Students will need a computer.



#### 2. Completion of TWO assessments between November 7 and December 10, 2022

#### **Alternative PSAT 8/9 and NNAT3 Testing Dates**

- > These are only for students who are absent when the test is given at their foundation school, for students who live out of district, and for students who attend a private school or are home-schooled.
- > Students must register for an alternative testing session using the Registration Link below.

Please Note: Students are permitted to take each assessment one time only.



- 3. Have your 7<sup>th</sup> grade transcript uploaded and submitted to PTHS D209 by your school's registrar or counselor no later than January 15, 2023 using the Google Form provided
  - ➤ Students must contact their middle school and request an official transcript from the registrar or counselor It must include the student's full name, date of birth, and final grades in all core areas: English, math, science, and social studies.
  - ➤ Middle school registrars or counselors will upload the student's 7<sup>th</sup> grade transcripts to the Transcript Request Form: 7th Grade Transcript Form
  - ➤ When the registrar clicks "Submit" on the form, it will automatically be sent to the PTHS D209 Admissions repository.
  - Completed forms will only be considered official if they are submitted by the registrar or counselor, not by the student or parent.
  - ➤ Paper copies of transcripts will <u>not</u> be accepted.



# MSA Admissions Scoring Criteria Breakdown

MSA ADMISSIONS SCORING CRITERIA	WEIGHT
PSAT 8/9	35%
Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT3) Score	35%
7th Grade Transcripts*	30%



<sup>\*</sup> For  $7^{th}$  grade transcripts, there is a concordance scale in which each letter grade has a numeric designation (A = 4; B = 3; etc.) to convert into an admissions score.
