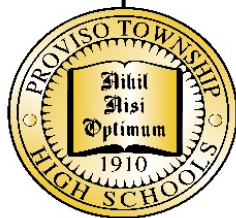

Hi Proviso Families,

We're hosting vaccination clinics at all three of our schools this Thursday, September 30th from 1 pm-8 pm. This event is open to our staff, our students, their eligible family members, and members of the community who would like to be vaccinated. Here is what will be available:

1st Dose: For individuals who have not received any vaccination shots yet.

2nd Dose: For individuals who received the first dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccination after September 1st, 2021.

Booster: The booster shot is **ONLY** available to people who:

- Received their 2nd dose of the Pfizer vaccine before March 30, 2021.
- Are 65 and older and live in a long-term care facility.
- Are 18 or older with an underlying health condition or work in a high-risk environment.
- The booster is NOT available to individuals who have already received a Moderna or Johnson and Johnson vaccination.

Because this event is happening during school hours, it is important that individuals **REGISTER IN ADVANCE** if they plan to be vaccinated. Registration links for each school are below.
