All Freshmen take required courses of English 1, Integrated Math 1, Biology, and World Civilizations or AP World History. For Physical Education (PE), you will choose Freshmen PE/Health OR NJROTC: Naval Science 1. For Elective courses, you will rank your 1st through 5th choices. (Your 3rd, 4th, and/or 5th choices will be used if your 1st and 2nd choices cannot fit into your schedule.) Elective courses may be taken all in one department or from different departments. For more information, please see the SY27 Academic Programs & Course Catalog on the district website.

Please Note: (1) Selecting a course is <u>not</u> a guarantee that you will automatically be enrolled in that course. Course offerings are dependent on enrollment and staffing. (2) Diverse Learners and Multilingual Learners will be placed in general education equivalent classes based on individual student need. (3) Students whose standardized Reading/Math test scores are below grade level may be placed in Reading 1 or Algebraic Reasoning as their elective. (4) Based on reading and math scores, students may be placed in Honors courses in English, Math, Science, and/or Social Studies. Families will be notified prior to the start of school.
