DREAM

DREAM is an Alternative Learning Opportunity Program offered at Proviso East High School and is a partnership between Proviso School District 209 and West 40. Referrals to DREAM are for students who are behind in credit and need extra support. For 3 periods of their regular school day, students work in Personalized Learning Centers. There, they are enrolled in co-taught, original credit Math and English courses; in addition to a period of credit recovery, where students can make up missing credits. All DREAM students are assigned a Student Advocate. Advocates provide support to the students, communicate with Parents/Guardians and school staff, help the student hold themselves accountable, and to be successful in school and beyond.
