Are students required to attend ELOS?

Attendance at ELOS is expected of all students. This is time dedicated to help students succeed and/or extend their learning. If students are assigned to ELOS to make-up exams or complete missing assignments, failure to attend may forfeit their opportunity to make up the work.
