## Illinois School Report Card - 2018

## **Dear Parents:**

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) released our annual School Report Card on Oct. 31. The Report Card shows how well our school is progressing on a wide range of educational goals. *Proviso Math and Science's* data show 100% graduation rate, 82% are proficient in English Language Arts, 86% proficient in Science and 72% proficient in math. In the last four years we have shown an upward bound trajectory, starting with Spring 2015 whereas 69% of our students met and exceeded in ELA and 46% met and exceeded in math. We have come a long way and wear our accolades with pride.

As part of the new support and accountability system that launched this year, ISBE has identified our school to receive the designation *Exemplary*. This is the highest designation a school can receive. We welcome this designation and are ready to build on the talent of our incredible teachers and staff and look forward to including parents, families, and community partners in the work ahead.

We will continue to collect data and evidence comparing our current organizational and instructional practices to our past indicators that have been the hallmarks of our successful school.

Each school's Report Card also now includes a designation, a descriptor of how well our school is meeting the needs of all students, based on 10 measures of performance including growth. This way, we can chart the path to where we want to go together.

Our school's designation is *Exemplary*, which means we do not rest on our laurels but continue to strive to the next level by way of parental involvement, more partnerships with businesses and universities and more professional development for our teachers that will empower our continued success.
