The Academy Student Advisory Board will provide support in the planning and execution of Academy events and represent the interests of their peers. This is a significant responsibility and your interest in serving in this role is appreciated. If you are appointed to a position, please understand that the time commitment will vary throughout the year. Generally you should expect 2-4 meetings per month, occasional weekend commitments, and some work through the summer. Though appointed students are responsible for planning events, growing our academies and fostering academy spirit, much of what students will gain from serving on the Advisory Board will come in the relationships and leadership skills that develop through the work.

As appointed student leaders, each member of Academy Student Advisory Board is always to set an appropriate example for others (a behavior expectations contract is part of the application). You will be expected to promote academy spirit and pride, stand by your unique and creative ideas, attend all board activities, cooperate with others, be positive, and be willing to take risks. Academy Student Advisory Board is a fun, energetic and active club; and we are very excited that you want to be a part of it. There are high expectations for those that serve on their Academy's Advisory Board, but there are few clubs or other means by which you can contribute as lasting and as positive a legacy to Proviso East.
