The PSAT 8/9, Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability Test and Written Academy Essay must be completed on the dates indicated below. There are no makeup dates, other than those listed.

(Use enclosed forms.) **Mathematics Teacher Recommendation** You must request that your school send your Official School Transcripts for the entire 7th Grade transcripts to PMSA by January 15th Administered by District 209 to eligible students at Proviso feeder schools between October 22nd and November 2, 2018. Additional testing dates for students who do not attend one of the feeder schools or for those who were absent during their scheduled testing are listed below: Make Up Dates: Proviso West High School: November 3rd (8:00am) OR Proviso East High School: November 10th **PSAT 8/9** (8:00am) You must register for a scheduled make up exam by contacting Proviso East (708) 202-1613 or Proviso West (708) 202-6313 in advance of the test date. No walk-ins will be admitted. The final testing date for the PSAT 8/9 for the purpose of PMSA admissions is November 10, 2018. Students applying to PMSA must complete the Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability **Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability Test** Test and Written Academy Essay at PMSA on either October 13, November 17, OR December 8, 2018.

*All accepted students in the Class of 2023 will be automatically enrolled in the PMSA Pre-International Baccalaureate® (IB) Program.



Appointments are not necessary to take this exam. All eligible applicants may test.

(The final testing date for the Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability Test and Admissions

Essay for the purpose of PMSA admissions is December 8, 2018.)

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Proviso Mathematics and Science Academy is selective. Students are chosen from the 8th grade only.

Residency Requirement: Please note that students must reside with a parent or legal guardian who is a resident of Proviso Township High Schools District 209 to be enrolled at PMSA. If invited, you will be required to show proof of residency at the time of enrollment. If you have any questions about this, please contact our office.

SELECTION PROCESS / NOTIFICATION

The selection process takes place during late January and early February, with notification of enrollment mailed shortly thereafter.

The Proviso Mathematics and Science Academy selection process for the Class of 2023 is based on a point system, with a maximum of 400 points:

- PSAT 8/9 Exam (35% or 140 points)
- Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test[®] (26% or 104 points)
- 7th Grade School Transcript Grades (22% or 88 points)
- Academy Essay Conventions/Organization (5% or 20 points)
- Academy Essay Quality of Response (5% or 20 points)
- Middle School Mathematics Teacher Recommendation (3.5% or 14 points)
- Middle School Science Teacher Recommendation (3.5% or 14 points)

The cutoff score for the Proviso Mathematics and Science Academy selection process is derived from the applicant pool and is not generated before the selection process. The number of students invited for enrollment to the Academy depends on an effort to maintain a consistent overall student enrollment at PMSA. Applicants who present the strongest combination of credentials and have the highest application score are invited to attend.
