Minutes

1. Introduction

The action from this Committee is progress towards a recommendation to the BOE Finance and Facilities Committee.

Attendees: Executive Committee, Dr. Patrick Hardy, Antoinette Rayburn, and Mary O'Rourke Absent: Paul Starck-King and L.T. Taylor

2. East Auto Shop

- The original FMP suggested relocating the East auto shop to inside the main building which is not feasible now.
- A decision must be made regarding the question: is the auto shop in the right place now?
- Dr. Hardy addressed the Committee with several concerns: (1) the auto shop is too far away from the main campus; (2) security issues due to the remote location with entering and exiting; (3) never liked the current location and suggested a key card system for those students enrolled in the program
- Initially, there was a push back from East in relocating the auto shop
- The Committee discussed exploring the opportunity to move the location
- There needs to be a financial discussion because equipment has been purchased for the program for FY20

3. HLS Work

- Perkins & Will explained that they will review work upon completion; they did ask how the funds are being tracked
- Ron Anderson stated that there are funds for the FMP and HLS; PMSA quotes are complete
- Angelo Calcagno explained most work will be completed in-house; however, some work to be bid
- Updates on work should be sent to Perkins & Will Jessica Wagner has not received an update in over a month

- Perkins & Will is working on the drawings reducing scope based on drawings bidding by August 16th
- The scanning of blueprints (given to ARC by building managers) should be complete by the end of July
- Michael Dolter stated that it is a high priority to obtain the mechanical drawings at East and West
- Perkins & Will need access to the scans email links to be sent per Ron

4. Other FY20 work for completion

- Spring FY20 Advanced Manufacturing at West committing monies for abatement
- Infrastructure work to be completed TBD
- The parking lots are scheduled for the summer of '20

5. IT consideration for HLS and FY20 work

 The Committee explained that the IT department attends the building meetings as FMP progression occurs
