If a language other than English is spoken in the home and/or the student speaks a language other than English.

Then student data is vetted before language proficiency is screened pursuant to Section 228.15 of the Illinois Administrative Code.

If a student qualifies to be screened the student will be given the Screener to assess English language proficiency in listening, reading, speaking, and writing.

If a student scores below an Overall Composite Proficiency score of 5.0 then the student is eligible for ELL/Bilingual Services. Parents are notified of student's eligibility. Once a student qualifies for services, the student is assessed annually with the ACCESS test.
