

If a language other than English is spoken in the home and/or the student speaks a language other than English.

Than student data is vetted before language proficiency is screened pursuant to Section 228.15 of the Illinos Adminstrative Code.

If a student qualifies to be screened the student will be given the Screener to assess English language proficiency in listening, reading, speaking, and wirting. English is the only language spoken in the home.

Student is placed in the general education program; no further action is necessary.

If a student scores below an Overall Composite Proficiency score of 5.0 then the student is eligible for ELL/Bilingual Services. Parents are notified of student's eligibility. Once a student qualifies for services, the student is assessed annually with the ACCESS test.
